

MARKET TRENDS: HOW THE INDUSTRY AND TECHNOLOGY MAKE A DIFFERENCE

We are experiencing increased demand for strong professionals, both those with niche technology skills and junior profiles with a higher education background. More and more clients are requiring candidates to offer a combination of IT technical knowledge and business experience/knowledge, ideally within the same industry.

We are seeing significant deviations from the norm in salaries in three major sectors of activity: banking, commodity trading and pharmaceutical/medical device. These three sectors typically pay up to around 20% over and above the top end of the usual market range.

Regarding the niche and/or new technologies that employers increasingly expect candidates to offer, we have identified 4 technological trends that influence salaries:

- Infrastructure / Support ↘



Location plays a part as well. There is a noticeable gap in salaries between major cities such as Zurich and Geneva and the rest of Switzerland.

CANDIDATES' EXPECTATIONS: IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT THE MONEY

Candidates are generally looking to consolidate their career and to move into positions that represent either a change of sector (to broaden their experience) or a step up in their career.

While compensation is undeniably still key for candidates, other factors influence their decision on whether to take on a new role. The technological environment, the nature of the project or the responsibilities of the role itself carry increasing weight for tech-savvy candidates.

Candidates also expect the workplace to adapt more to their needs, with opportunities for flexible hours and working from home. This is especially the case within the IT development community and can be explained by the fact that many are working as freelance contractors, juggling concurrent projects.
