Update your profile

If the platform where you are doing the interview allows, include a professional photo.



Take care of your image

A neat, professional image is very important, both in a face to face interview and in a virtual interview. Make a good first impression by wearing professional clothing. Try to have light in front of you, not behind.



Be aware of the background

Make sure the background is as professional and simple as possible so as not to distract the interviewer.



No interruptions

Reduce them to a minimum. Put your mobile on silence, tell the rest of the people at home that you have an interview, deactivate alerts...



Look at the camera

Centre your attention directly on the interviewer. This way you will seem more engaged. The interviewer will be able to see clearly your interest in the job.



Wait for your turn to speak

There can be delays in communication due to the connection. It is important to wait a few seconds to avoid interrupting.



Ask about the interview process

Ask your interviewer what the next steps are, when you can expect to find out if you are progressing, and what the timescale is for the hiring process. This is vital information!
